General Rules and Regulations of B.Ed. Course:

Nandalal Ghosh B.T. College, Panpur, affiliated to West Bengal University of Teachers Training, Education Planning and Administration, West Bengal, offers the B. Ed course recognized by NCTE. The General Rules and Regulations of B.Ed. Programme is according to the guidelines of WBUTTEPA and NCTE new regulations 2014. The General Rules and Regulations of B.Ed. Programme are:

1. The Duration of the B.Ed. Programme is of two academic years covered with four semesters. The maximum duration to complete the course may be taken up to maximum of three years from the date of admission.
2. The medium of instruction will be Bengali and English.
3. The total number of seats will be 50 /one unit and distributed as 25 seats for in-service candidates (deputed) and 25 seats for fresh candidates (fresher). In case of seats not filled up by any group will be allotted for the other group..
4. The general rules of reservation for SC/ST and PH/others will be followed as per rules of State of W.B., WBUTTEPA and UGC. In case any seats lying vacant for any category that will be offered to the other category in the merit list. (OBC A & B will be treated as general category)
5. Free Structure:
Registration/Application Fee for both Fresher & Deputed)
Rs. 500.00 for General
Rs. 300.00 for SC/ST/PH
Admission fee:
Rs. 39,500.00 for each year for Fresher Candidate
Rs. 40,500.00 for each year for Deputed Candidate

Intake Capacity: 50 (Deputed: 25 & Fresher: 25)

- i. Language Group:
 - a. English -06
 - b. Bengali-06
 - c. Sanskrit-06
- ii. Social science Group:
 - a. Education-08
 - b. History-07
- iii. Science: Physical Science(Physics or Chemistry)-09
- iv. Mathematics-08

Eligibility for admission to B.Ed. Course:

- Candidates should be a graduate in a school subject from a recognized University.
- The candidate must have at least 50% marks in the Bachelor's Degree (General)/ in the Master's Degree in School Subjects.
- Bachelor in Engineering or Technology with Science or Mathematics with 55% marks or any other Degree equivalent thereto, are eligible for admission for the B.Ed. Programme. Such candidates are required to enter the marks of B.E /B.Tech in the row of Honours Degree. The M.E/ M.Tech result will be entered in Master's Degree row.
- The Honours Graduates in the school subjects should enter the Honours marks only in the Bachelor's Degree(Honours).
- In case of General Graduates, the total marks obtained in general subjects should be entered in the Bachelor's degree (general).
- For candidates with less than 50% marks in the Honours degree, the total marks of pass and honours subjects will be considered. If it becomes 50% or more, that score will be entered in Graduate (general) row .
- For fresh candidates the merit list will be prepared separately for each school subject based on Scoring.
- For Deputed candidates the merit lists will be prepared separately for each school subject **based on the Date of Joining. If the date of Joining is the same, then academic score will be considered.**
- **The deputed candidates (PG/ Honours Graduate) will be admitted in particular subject in which he was appointed. For pass course teacher, the candidate will be allowed to select one method subject from the subjects for which he/she was appointed.**
- **Relaxation of minimum qualifying marks for SC/ST will be as per Govt. rules.**

For scoring in HS, the marks obtained in best five subjects excluding Environmental Studies will be considered.

For Deputed Candidates

Deputed Applicants must submit/ upload an attested copy of M.C. resolution recording the approval of Service in regard to his/her service with the Application Form.

Following additional documents are required to be submitted positively on the day of verification of documents in the College along with all certificates, mark sheets and other testimonials. (Candidates should come with all original documents along with one set of photocopies of the same for submission)

- Attested copy of M.C. resolution with regards to his/her deputation, countersigned by D. I. of Schools (Secondary).
- Certificate from Competent Authority whether the candidate teaches in Class IX or above.
- Three copies of passport size photographs of the applicant.
- A certificate with the following information is to be submitted from the Secretary or Headmaster/Headmistress (where he/she is serving) and counter signed by the D.I. of Schools of the District concerned:
 - Certified that the School is in receipt of aid on full/ deficit/ lumpsum grant basis or that school in unaided or salary deficit scheme one.
 - Certified that she/he is duly approved teacher.
 - Certified that she/he is being deputed by the school for undergoing two year B.Ed. Courses (2019-21)
- Release order from the school will be submitted on the day of Joining to the B.Ed. Course.
- Admission undertaking

Candidates pursuing any other course in the WBUTTEPA or any other University during 2019-21 academic session are not eligible for admission to the B. Ed. Programme for the session 2019-21.
